



CLUB TO PARTIALLY REOPEN WEDNESDAY, JUNE 3 LIMITED SERVICES AVAILABLE

On Thursday, May 28, the Mayor announced that the City will move into Phase 3 on Wednesday, June 3.

This means the ULCC is set to partially reopen, following the guidelines set forth in phase 3 of the Governor and Mayor's plans.

This allows us to open various areas and limit capacity.

Hours of Operation will be Monday-Friday 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

WHAT IS OPEN:

- Barber Shop & Esthetician (No shave or beard trim. Reservations through Club Services only.)
- Café ONE: Coffee and take out (no seating)
- Take out food from Café ONE and the Carvery (4th floor): Limited menu for both areas, up until 4:00 p.m.
- The ULCC Take out Market Tuesday-Friday (see the website for details and ordering)
- Presidents Hall Only (2nd floor): social distancing between tables as well as small groups.
- The Library and Business Information Center (4th floor)
- 5th floor tables will be set up for work areas when the need arises.
- 8th floor meeting rooms as well as Board Room (5th floor), Heritage Room (2nd floor) and 7th floor meeting rooms available by appointment through the Catering office.
- Personal Training (including squash and racquetball) by appointment only | Book through Josh Vron dran at jvrandran@ulcc.org. Personal Training is open to ALL ULCC Members.
- Small meetings (10 people or less) limited options.
- Guest Rooms to open June 8.
- Cigar Deck (10 people max) no alcohol.

WHAT IS NOT OPEN:

- Athletic & Fitness facilities (No swimming pool, locker rooms and showers)
- Rendezvous Bar (No bar service yet)
- Dining in the Carvery or Café ONE (take out only)
- No on-site events (all events are still virtual)

NEW PROCEDURES: JUNE 3-30, 2020

- Open Hours: Monday – Friday 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Closed Saturday & Sunday
- Masks will be required for all members in all public areas and when not social distancing.
- Masks are also required for all staff.
- Temperatures will be read for EVERYONE upon entering the building
- Federal street will be the only open door to the Club. (Jackson will be closed)
- Members must check in at the NEW lobby desk before proceeding.
- ALL members will be required to have a membership card with a photo. If you do not have one, our membership team will be in the Lobby to take your photo and give you a new card. We will also be using these cards for payment to your account and moving away from “chits.”
- Only 5 people allowed in the elevator at one time.
- Guests will be asked to wait in the lobby for the member to escort them.
- We ask that everyone follows the CDC guidelines:
- If you are sick, have been in large groups or have symptoms, you will need to STAY HOME! Some questions to consider before coming to the clubhouse:
- Have you been in contact with anyone who has experienced COVID-19 symptoms or traveled to a known “hotspot?”
- Are you experiencing a cough, shortness of breath or sore throat?
- Have you had a fever in the last 48 hours?
- Have you had new loss of taste or smell?
- Have you had vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours?
- It is our goal to protect everyone that comes into the Club and we will require everyone to follow the rules.

As we move towards phase 4 (hopefully in early July), we will reopen Café ONE and the Carvery & Rendezvous for food and beverage dine-in and the Athletics facilities.
